

- » Obey speed limits; accelerate gently; inflate tires properly
- » Replace light bulbs with ENERGY STAR compact fluorescents

- » Patronize farmers' markets

- » Walk, bike, carpool or ride TARC

- » Be a savvy consumer: buy durable and buy local
- » Use ceiling fans; raise the thermostat 2° in summer
- » Wear a sweater; lower the thermostat 2° in winter
- » Install low-flow shower heads and faucet aerators; wash clothes in cold water
- » Reduce, Reuse, Recycle, Restore
